

The PUR Packet developed by Proctor & Gamble

The PUR packet turns 10 liters of dirty, potentially deadly water into clean and drinkable water.



10 cents = 1 packet 1 packet = 10 liters of clean water \$1.00 = clean water for 50 days \$30.00 = clean water for a family for a year

> over 3 billion liters of water have been cleaned so far



Delta Kappa Gamma Partnerships with UNICEF

In 1996 the Gambia Project, which assisted girls to remain in school by providing funds for their education, was launched.

In November 1999 we joined in the Pro-Maya Project to assist children and their schools in Chiapas, Mexico.

In July 2003 the Society was invited to support a partnership for teacher education in Afghanistan.

By June 2009 the final total raised for the Afghanistan project alone was \$203,124, and altogether members have raised over \$273,000 in support of the Gambia, Pro Maya

and Afghanistan projects.

We have now become part of the Schools for Africa project.






