- 1. Discuss what the Outstanding Service Form is at your first meeting in September or October.
- 2. Assign the second vice president to oversee the follow up for finding someone to be eligible for the Outstanding Service Award in September or October.
- 3. Receive the nominations and letters of recommendation by your second meeting in November and December.
- 4. Present the nomination forms and letters of recommendation to the Outstanding Service Award Committee by Jan. 15, 2014 (send to Colleen Spieler Chair).
