OVERVIEW

The Seven Purposes are what we do and the Strategic Plan is how we do it.

The Ad Hoc Strategic Action Plan committee has presented a working copy of the Alpha Kappa State Strategic Action Plan to the Executive Board. The responsibility for continued strategic action planning and implementation has been assigned to the Alpha Kappa State Executive Board.

PLANNING PROCESS

The Alpha Kappa State Action Plan provides for a continuous review and updating of identified action programs that implement the seven purposes, the mission and vision of the Society. The plan is divided into major areas of focus, objectives, and activities. Suggested personnel and committees responsible are listed.

The status of the major areas of focus, objectives and activities are to be reviewed every two years at a meeting of the Executive Board. All members responsible for goal objectives shall contribute pertinent data for the review. All areas will be reviewed and the activities will be determined to be Accomplished/Established Practice, New, Continue, In Progress, Renewed, Revised, and/or Deleted. Once an activity is determined to be Accomplished or has become an Established Practice, it is moved to Appendix A of the Strategic Action Plan. When an objective or activity is first added, it is indicated as New. Activities that have been implemented and are continuing are indicated as Continue. Those that have been initiated but are not fully implemented are indicated In Progress. Activities that may not have been addressed recently and/or require more emphasis are listed as Renewed and those that are continuing but have been changed in any way, are indicated as Revised. When an objective or activity is no longer applicable, it is indicated as Deleted and moved to Appendix B of the Strategic Action Plan.

As the Executive Board reviews the AKS Action Plan and major areas of focus, objectives or activities are added, revised, deleted, etc., the latest review/revision date will be noted.

AKS chapters are encouraged to develop their own action plans.
